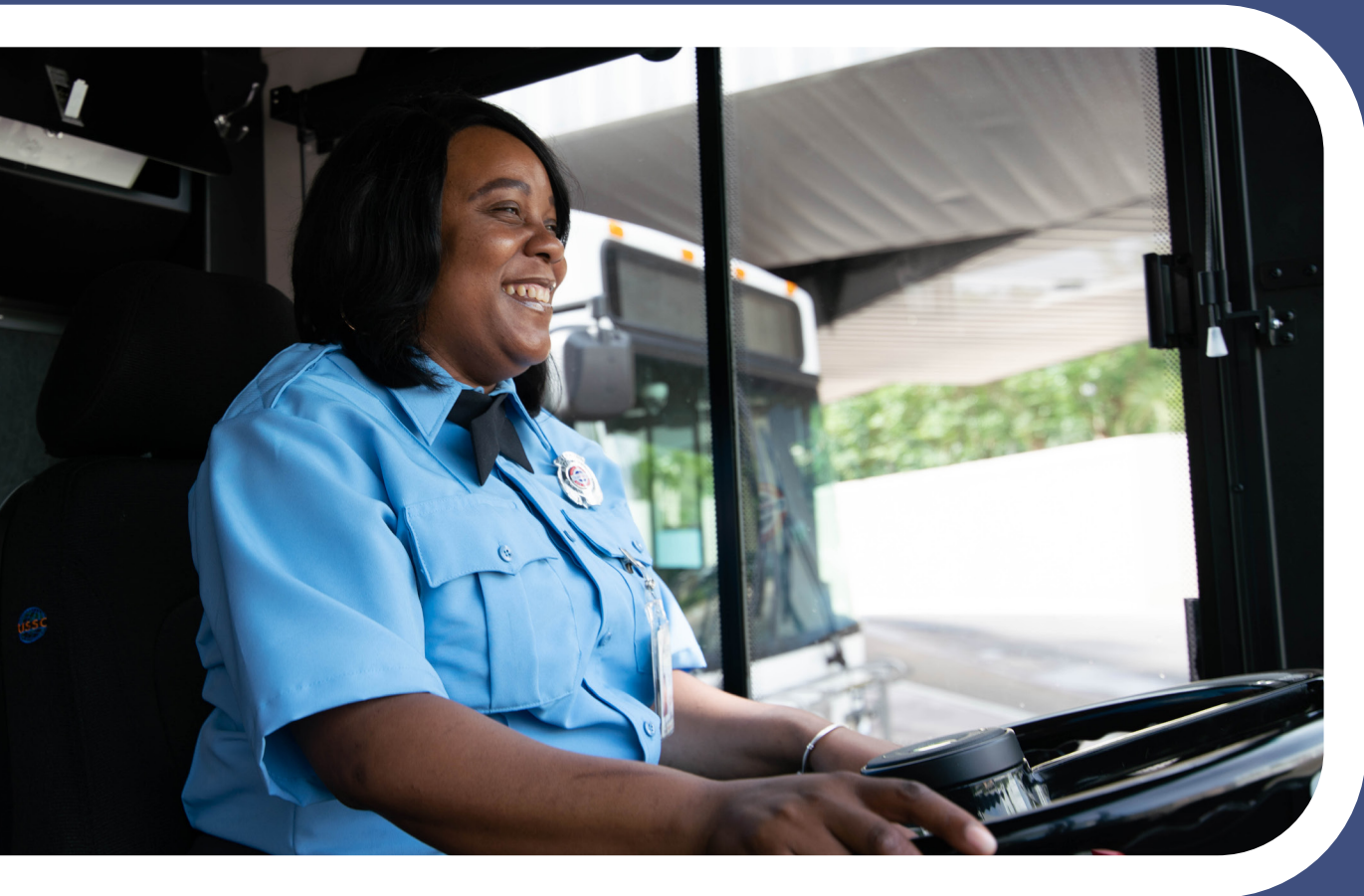

YOUR GUIDE TO STARMETRO'S POTENTIAL NIGHT AND SUNDAY SERVICE



POTENTIAL ROUTE UPDATES

A (Azalea) will travel on Tennessee Street from Capital Circle NW to CK Steele Plaza and the Governor’s Square Mall (ending at Apalachee Parkway) in both directions. There will not be service on Old Saint Augustine Road.

B (Big Bend) will travel from the Macon community to Capital Circle SE, with a stop at CK Steele Plaza and the Southside Transit Center. The route will stay on Monroe Street between for most of the route from Tharpe Street (north of the C.K. Steele Plaza) to Palmer Avenue (north of the Southside Transit Center). The southern loop will match the B route daytime changes, shifting most stops on Woodville Highway to Ross Road and Crawfordville Road.

M (Moss) will mostly remain the same. The M route will continue to serve stops on Orange Avenue between Pasco Street and Jim Lee Road, but it will not travel south of Orange Avenue or serve South Monroe Commons.

T (Tall Timbers) will travel from Tallahassee Community College (TCC) to C.K. Steele Plaza traveling on Jackson Bluff Road eastbound (towards the Plaza). The route will travel on Pensacola Street westbound (towards TCC). Service on Lake Bradford Road and Robert and Trudie Perkins Way will be discontinued.

New **Crosstown Route** will operate at night, connecting the Providence neighborhood (Levy Avenue and McCaskill Street) with FAMU, Orange Avenue, and the Southside Transit Center. The route will turn around at the Southside Transit Center.

FSU’s **Nite Nole** will connect FSU Campus with TCC along Tennessee Street (westbound) and Pensacola Street (eastbound). Areas along High Road and Ocala Road will also be served.

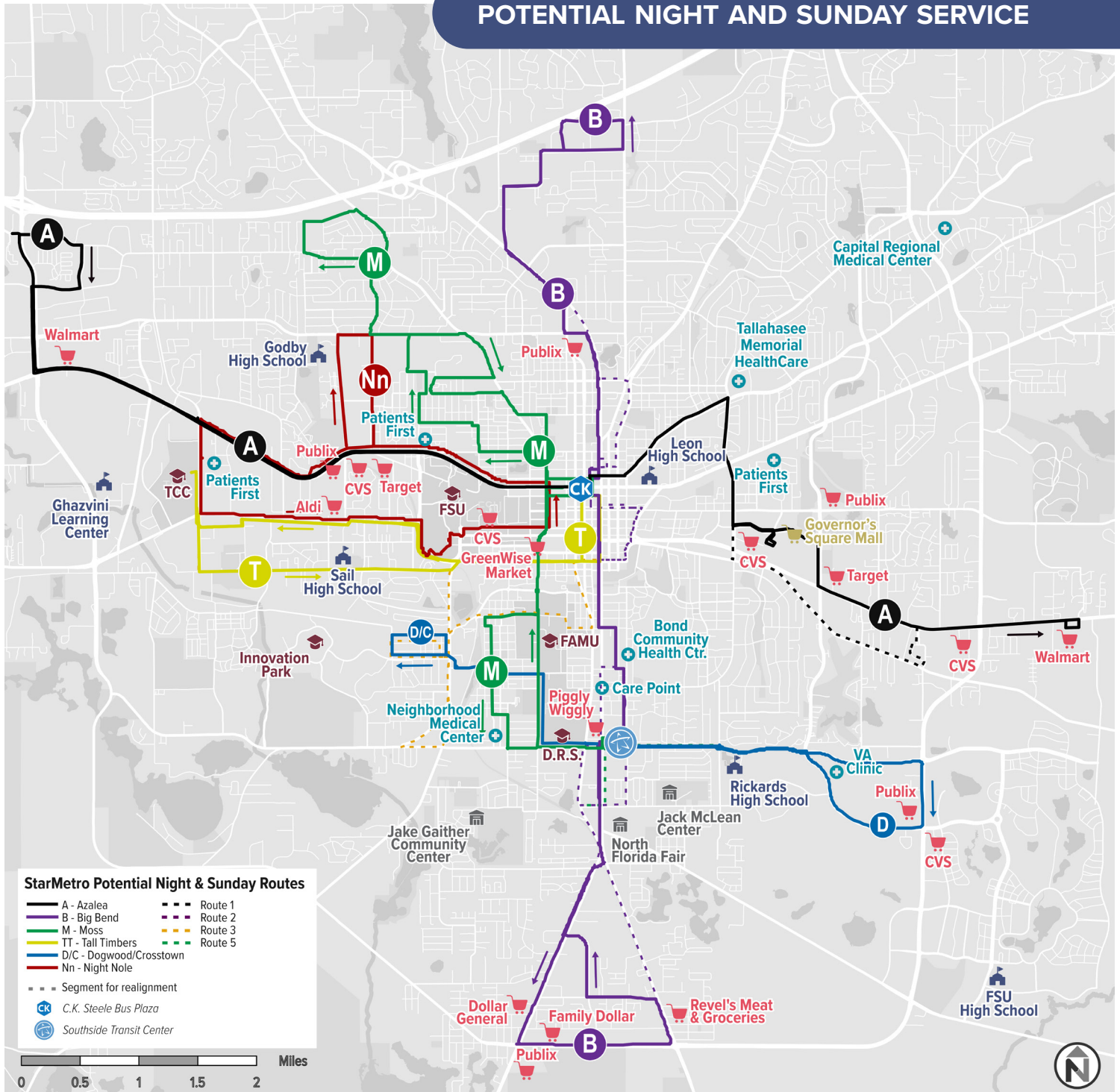

Updates to the Night and Sunday service will increase access and efficiency.

BENEFITS OF POTENTIAL CHANGES:

- ★ You can get to major employers, shopping, and services after 7 p.m., including Tallahassee Medical Center (TMC), Governor's Square Mall, Centre of Tallahassee, and the three major universities.
- ★ Students, faculty, and staff at FSU, FAMU and TCC have access to public transit on evenings and on weekends.
- ★ Tallahassee neighborhoods, including Macon Community, Frenchtown, Bond, and Providence, will have bus service in the evening and on Sundays.
- ★ Bus routes will connect with the new Southside Transit Center, giving customers direct access to more opportunities.
